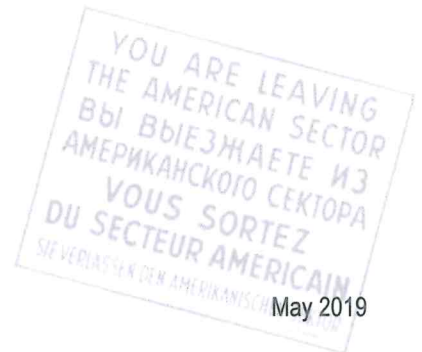

The Crimean journalist Anna Andriievaska and the staff member of the Ukrainian Institute for National Remembrance, Olena Khalimon present in their book how the Russian army conquered the Ukrainian peninsula in 2014.

More than fifty witnesses confirm that the Crimea was not taken „without shots“ but by force, and not with the absolute consent of local residents. but against the will of the population.

In the framework of the event will be also shown a documentary film of the Ukrainian journalist Ihor Chayka and the Belarusian TV channel Beltsat "Crimea Island. Dejavu" about how and why Crimea came under Russian Federation control.
