Kitchen Table Talk to Global Forum

Virtual Conference University of Guelph, Guelph, ON/Canada May 11-15, 2021

Due to the circumstances resulting from COVID-19, the 2021 RWSA Triennial Conference is going virtual. Although we regret that we cannot meet in person as originally planned, we are excited about the opportunity to host a virtual conference that allows for a more diverse range of panel presentations and participants. Any paper and panel submissions that have already been made will still be considered; however, we have extended the deadline to allow for additional submissions to be made until Sept. 30, 2020.

The theme “Kitchen Table Talk to Global Forum” emphasizes how conversations, relationships, and food shape rural communities. This theme allows for the consideration of the ways that gendered, sexual, ethnic, and racial identities affect personal power, class consciousness, individual choice, and community development. These subjects lend themselves to the exploration of rural activism, social justice, innovation, politics, business development, cultural expression, self-governance, and collective experiences — both historical and contemporary — in local, regional, national, and global settings.

RWSA is an international association founded in 1997 to promote and advance farm and rural women's/gender studies in a historical perspective by encouraging research, promoting scholarship, and establishing and maintaining links with organizations that share these goals. RWSA welcomes public historians and archivists, graduate students, and representatives of rural organizations and communities as conference participants and members, in addition to academic scholars from diverse fields, including sociology, anthropology, literature and languages, Indigenous Studies, and history.

Presentations take many forms at this virtual RWSA conference. Possibilities include workshops, panel sessions, virtual tours, interactive sessions, roundtable discussions, poster

presentations, open-mic discussions, performances, readings, and audiovisual presentations. As much as possible, presentations and conference activities will take place in a synchronous environment. Virtual tours, posters, or other forms of presentations may be pre-recorded with the consent of the program committee.

The RWSA encourages inter-, trans- or multi-disciplinary approaches that connect rural women's/gender history and present-day concerns. The RWSA seeks to integrate creative work with the conference theme, and we encourage artists working in visual, film, performative, and literary genres to submit their ideas to make the conference most dynamic.

The theme: "Kitchen Table Talk to Global Forum" encourages exploration of several sub-themes:

- Women and mental health
- Women and food justice
- Indigenous rural women
- Women and food tourism
- Women and technological and biological innovation (media, healthcare, equipment)
- What's on the table (food production, preparation, rituals, hospitality, etiquette, and display)
- Women's Table talk (issues concerning family, community, politics, legislation, and markets)

The University of Guelph is known as Canada's Food University and has gained international recognition for its impact on agricultural sciences and rural life. Submissions should be sent electronically (as a single Word document or combined PDF) to RWSA2021@gmail.com by September 30, 2020.

Bilan de la jeune recherche sur le Canada en Europe

La revue Études Canadiennes/Canadian Studies (revue bilingue et bi-annuelle) a le plaisir d'annoncer un numéro bilan sur la jeune recherche en Europe sur le Canada. Ce numéro s'adresse aux jeunes chercheurs de tous les champs disciplinaires des sciences humaines : histoire, histoire de l'art, sociologie, géographie, ethnologie, études autochtones, littérature, droit, sciences politiques, etc.... en cours de doctorat ou récemment diplômés, qui consacrent l'intégralité ou une large partie de leur travail à l'étude du Canada. Le numéro sera l'occasion pour eux de présenter les nouvelles thématiques, problématiques, méthodes de recherche et concepts qui émergent aujourd'hui au sein des études canadiennes en Europe.

Les propositions d'articles (250 à 300 mots) contenant un titre et un résumé décrivant l'objectif de l'article, et incluant une courte biographie (100 mots maximum) doivent être envoyées en format Word à la rédactrice en chef de la revue, Laurence Cros: laurence.cros@u-paris.fr

La date limite pour la réception des propositions est le 1er octobre 2020. Le comité de rédaction confirmera rapidement leur pré-selection aux auteurs. Les articles complets

(d'environ 8000 mots) devront être envoyés pour le 1er janvier 2021. Ils seront soumis à la lecture à l'aveugle de deux experts. Les textes retenus paraîtront en version papier dans le N°90 (juin 2021), puis un an plus tard en libre accès sur <http://journals.openedition.org/eccs/>

Virtual Canadian Studies

What is Virtual Canadian Studies all about?

- it focuses on Canada and Canadian issues in the format of interdisciplinary courses,
- it is an opportunity to learn more about Canada through long distance Elearning,
- it is an easy access to resources on Canada worldwide,
- it provides access to courses by specialists on Canada from different German universities,
- it allows participants to earn credit points (from 3 to 7, based on chosen level) that can be used towards programs at home universities (Bachelor, Master etc.) (check with your own university before enrolling),
- students will receive a special certificate by the GKS testifying to their course participation,

- it is a great experience to get acquainted with new forms of learning and digital media.

Course Format and Requirements Duration: 12-14 weeks (full German university term)

Language: English or French Format: long-distance e-learning, courses are taught on a biweekly basis (double sessions) Course requirements:

- critical reading of the texts provided by the lecturers
- written assignments for each session
- regular participation in online discussion forum and chats
- submission of a final term paper

Entry requirements:

- enrolment in a university program (second-year level or above)
- proficiency in English or French
- online access
- interest in Canada
- registration fee: 50 Euro (participants outside the Euro Zone: 60 Euro)
