“Still Trump’s Party: How Local Republican Leaders Made Up their Minds in the 2024 Presidential Nomination”



From the very beginning of primary and caucus season, the outcome was clear: the Republican Party had already decided on Donald Trump. This is a substantial departure from history as no major party has renominated a losing presidential aspirant since 1968. Dr. Masket's talk will examine the impact rule changes have had on party decision-making, campaigning- including the role that the various 2023 criminal indictments against Trump played in helping this nomination campaign- governing and American democracy.

Dr Seth Masket is a professor at the Department of political science at the University of Denver and serves as the director of The Center on American Politics.
