## Genia Kostka & Ming Ma

Freie Universität Berlin Credible Information, Strategic Signal, or Both? Authoritarian-Aligned Narratives and Public Opinion



**Genia Kostka** is Professor of Chinese Politics at the Freie Universität Berlin. Her research focuses on China's digital transformation, environmental politics and political economy. Her most recent research project explores how digital technologies are integrated into local decision-making and governance structures in China (ERC Starting Grant 2020-2025).

**Ming Ma** is a Postdoctoral researcher at FU Berlin. His research focuses on political communication, authoritarian politics, and Al governance. Ma utilizes computational methods with large-scale datasets to examine the framing strategies of Russia and China in bloc-building narratives. His work has been published in peer-reviewed journals, including Perspectives on Politics, China Review, China Perspectives, among other journals.
