In addition to three guest speakers on the topic of the conference, eight students will have the chance to give a 20-minute lecture (in German or English) followed by a Q&A session.

The content of your talk can be any philosophical topic – whether that be practical or theoretical philosophy, feminist philosophy or formal logic. Contributions on the topic of marginalization are welcome as well. Maybe you have a term paper you are proud of or another philosophical topic you are passionate about? We would be happy if you share your ideas with us!

... and what your talk will be about incl. your theses and your argumentation (approx. 500-800 words).
