

Who can apply?

The direct exchange programme is open to all fully enrolled students of Freie Universität Berlin (exception: students of medicine, pharmacy, veterinary medicine). Prerequisites for participation in the direct exchange program are above all good academic performance (at least an average grade of 2.5) and very good language skills in the language of the destination country or the language of instruction at the partner institution.

When to apply?

Bachelor's students usually apply in the 3rd semester in order to go abroad in their 5th/6th semester. Master's students usually apply in the 1st semester in order to go abroad in their 3rd/4th semester. The application deadlines are always in the winter semester.

How does the application work?

Please send us all application documents by email: auslstud@fu-berlin.de. All PDF documents should be compressed into a ZIP file labelled with your surname. The letters of recommendation should also be sent directly to us as PDFs by the recommender. Applicants are selected during the winter semester in a two-stage process: written pre-selection and the final selection interview. The selection panel then decides on the final nominations.
